Align resources to support the vision and goals (i.e., collaborative time, the right people, and funding)

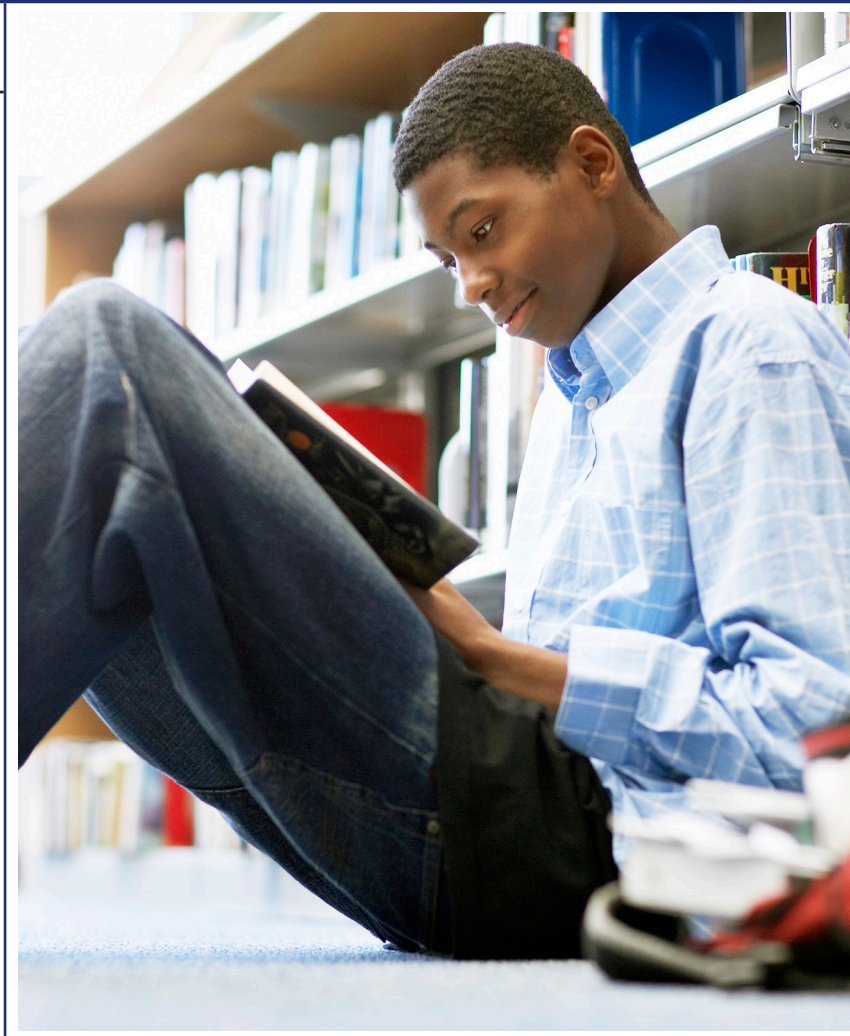
Establish a guaranteed viable curriculum and aligned district assessment practices within a tiered framework that meet the needs of all children
